By foot (20-30 minutes): From the MTCC, walk east along Front St. W. Turn left on York Street and walk five large city blocks to Queen Street. The Law Society is at the intersection of York St. and Queen St. The Lamont Learning Centre is on the east side of the building. **By subway (15-20 minutes):** From Union Station, take the University line north two stations to Osgoode Station. The station exits at the corner of University Ave. and Queen St. The Law Society is a short walk east down Queen St. The Lamont Learning Centre is on the east side of the building.
