

KIKANAWÊYIHTAKOSIN CÎ OHCI KISÊWÂTISI-IYINIW MACI-MASKIHKIY OSÂMI-OTINAMOWIN WIYASIWÊWIN?

Ôma Kisêwâtisi-iyiniw Maci-maskihkiy Osâmi-otinamowin Wiyasiwêwin ka-kî-kanawêyihtakosin mîna kotakak ka-sîhkitisahocik ka-ayâcik ahpô ka-âpacihâtâcik maci-maskihkiya, kîspin kinatonê nanâtawihîwêwin kiki kiya ahpô kotak awiyak ka-osâmi-otina.

The law **protects** against charges for:

- Having drugs for your own use (“simple possession”)
- Violating any condition of your parole, bail, probation, or conditional sentence (“house arrest”) from a previous **simple possession charge**

The law **does not protect** against charges for:

- Selling illegal drugs (trafficking): Police may suspect this if you have a large amount of drugs, cash, or items like scales, baggies, and debt lists
- Offences other than simple possession
- Any outstanding arrest warrants
- Violating any condition of your parole, bail, probation, or conditional sentence for **an offence that is not simple possession**
